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| Adnams, Ghost Ship, 4.5% abv, Suffolk <i>Brewed with a selection of malts - Pale Ale, Rye Crystal and Cara. They use Citra, and a blend of other American hop varieties to create some great citrus flavours.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |
| Tiny Rebel Cwtch, 4.6% abv, Newport Wales <i>This red ale has a Complex malt profile that supports a fruity hop burst and a snappy bitterness to end.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |
| Crouch Vale Brewers Gold, 4.0% abv, Essex <i>This multi-award-winning beer is pale, refreshing and extravagantly hoppy with gorgeous aromas of tropical fruits.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |
| Crouch Vale Yakima Gold, 4.2% abv, Essex <i>Very pale with delicious Amarillo hops, therefore earthily aromatic and highly drinkable.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |
| Crouch Vale Essex Boys Bitter 3.8% abv Essex <i>Full bodied, traditional-style mid-brown "best" brewed from 100% English barley malt and copious English Challenger and Boadicea hops, which shine through.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |
| Colchester Brewery Metropolis, 3.9% abv, Essex <i>A superb golden session beer, with enormous depth of flavour and a long floral, spicy finish from U.S. Cascade hops.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |
| Colchester Brewery Jack Spitty, 4.0% abv, Essex <i>Golden easy drinking summer ale. Full of hop flavour with delicate bitterness and light aroma.</i> | £3.80 pint - £1.90 ½ pint |

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| IP1 (Ipswich Pilsner 1), 4.2% abv, Belgium <i>Commissioned by us and brewed at the Huyghe Brewery in Belgium. Bready malt tones & subtle sweetness with a dry finish.</i> | £4.40 pint £2.20 ½ pint |
| Draught Cider Aspalls Harry Sparrow, 4.6% abv, Suffolk <i>Refreshing medium cider with cedar overtones.</i> | £4.40 pint £2.20 ½ pint |
| Northern Monk Neapolitan Pale Ale 5.9% abv <i>A pale ale brewed to mimic the shades of the classic Neapolitan ice cream with additions of lactose, strawberries, and chocolate sauce.</i> | £5.90 pint £2.95 ½ pint |
| Tiny Rebel Stay Puft (Porter), 5.2% abv, Newport Wales <i>Rich roast notes, a sticky sweetness and rich dried fruit flavours from the massive amounts of malt working to a higher strength.</i> | £4.90 pint £2.45 ½ pint |
| Tiny Rebel Beer Money IPA 6% abv Newport Wales <i>Mosaic and Citra are often used to unleash waves of tropical and citrus flavours into your beer, but they also have some great woody earth flavours. Put alongside the musky bittering of Simcoe, all of those flavours come out leaving the fruity notes more commonly associated with these hops.</i> | £5.20 pint £2.60 ½ pint |
| Bristol Beer Factory Milk Stout 4.5% abv (Over 23 Awards) <i>The original Bristol Milk Stout with smooth chocolatey sweetness and balancing coffee bitterness with hints of dark fruits. This award-winning national champion stout is a beautifully creamy, full-bodied stout.</i> | £4.70 pint £2.35 ½ pint |
| Redwell West Coast Pale Ale 5.6 %abv Norwich <i>Explosion of passion fruit nose, bags of grapefruit more tropical fruit in the aroma and taste, biscuit & caramel maltiness</i> | £5 pint £2.50 ½ pint |
| Thornbridge AM-PM Session Pale Ale 4.5% abv, Derbyshire <i>Bags of Tropical fruit and aromas, Pineapple, tangerine Guava and Passion fruit are balanced with a chewy, honeyed malt character</i> | £4.80 pint £2.40 ½ pint |
