1. Gold - Siren Broken Dream 6.5% abv Central and Southern

Breakfast stout with a gentle touch of smoke, coffee and chocolate.

2. Silver - Green Jack Ripper 8.5% abv East Anglia

Inspired by Belgian tripel ales, this multi-award winning brew is dangerously drinkable. Rich amber in colour; Ripper is sweet and fruity with a robust hop character and a warming finish.

3. Bronze - Mordue Workie Ticket 4.5% abv North East

A tasty, complex beer with malt and hops throughout and a long, satisfying bitter finish.

4. Best Mild - Greene King XX MILD 3% abv East Anglia

smooth, sweet and roasted flavour.

5. <u>Bitter (Logistics, Red McGregor not available)</u> <u>Replacement with the Silver - Mighty Oak Captain Bob 3.8% abv East Anglia</u>

A traditional deep amber coloured bitter brewed with Nelson Sauvin hop from New Zealand. The aroma is fruity and hoppy and on the palate; there is a slightly sweet maltiness that balances an easy going bitterness that is followed by hints of gooseberry, elderflower and grape in the finish.

6. Best Bitter - Mordue Workie Ticket 4.5% abv North East

A tasty, complex beer with malt and hops throughout and a long, satisfying bitter finish.

7. Golden Ales - Salopian Oracle 4% abv West Midlands

Oracle is a crisp, sparklingly sunflower gold ale with a striking hop profile. Dry and refreshing with a long citrus aromatic finish.

8. Strong Bitters - Dark Star Revelation 5.7% abv Surrey & Sussex

A blend of Columbus, Chinook, Cascade, Crystal and Warrior aroma hops by the sack full - then dry hopped during conditioning.

9. Speciality - Colchester Brewery Brazilian 4.6% abv East Anglia

coffee and vanilla porter. Not at all shy on flavour but beautifully balanced.

10. Bishop Nick 1555 4.3% abv East Anglia

With an unmistakably sweet nutty taste underlined by the ginger and fruit of Styrian goldings.
